Ahahui Koa Anuenue Begins Sale Of 2007-08 Ticket Packages

Honolulu – ‘Ahahui Koa Anuenue (AKA), the non-profit fundraising partner of the University of Hawai‘i at Manoa Athletics Department (UHAD), has begun new sales for 2007-08 ticket packages.

“More than 85 percent of those individuals who purchased the \$5,000, \$10,000, and \$20,000 packages last year have renewed for the 2007-08 academic year,” Vince Baldemor, AKA president, said. “We are now turning our attention to selling these packages to additional fans. Packages include: season tickets in premium locations for multiple sports, parking passes, invitations to special events, and other amenities. Our members also receive tax deductions for the donation portion of their package.”

“The proceeds from the sales of these packages go toward student-athlete scholarships. As housing, books, fees and other costs continue to increase, the athletics department depends more and more on these funds to support all of our teams and sports at UH,” Don Murphy, chairman of the board for Ahahui Koa Anuenue, said.
